



EUROREC *Rates EuroRec Seal Level 2*

The rates differ depending on the efforts to be done by The EuroRec Institute. The rates do not include services provided by the National Partner Organisations either in assisting the

1. Testing and Certification is done by a third party and the request for the EuroRec Seal is issued by a National Partner Organisation (ProRec Centre or an Associate of EuroRec).

The Third Party that performed the tests needs to be recognised by The EuroRec Institute or accepted by a National Authority as a certification body.

The costs encountered by the National Partner Organisation to evaluate the Testing and Certification done by that Third Party and the compliance with the EuroRec Seal Level 2 requirements are included in the fee due to the National Partner Organisation.

The costs related to the Third Party performing the quality assessment are out of scope of this pricing list.

The fee has to be paid after approval by the National ProRec Centre and before granting the EuroRec Seal.

Fee for National Partner Organisation

- 250€ - 750€ Western Europe
- 150€ - 300€ Eastern Europe (recent members of the European Union or candidate countries)

Rate for Issuing the Seal:

- 250€ Western Europe
- 150€ Eastern Europe (recent members of the European Union or candidate countries)

2. Testing and Certification is done by a Third Party and the request for the EuroRec seal is issued by that organisation, not being a National Partner Organisation (ProRec Centre or an Associate of EuroRec).

The Third Party that performed the tests needs to be recognised by The EuroRec Institute or accepted by a National Authority as a certification body.

The costs related to the Third Party performing the quality assessment are out of scope of this pricing list.

The costs encountered to evaluate the Testing and Certification done by that Third Party and the compliance with the EuroRec Seal Level 2 requirements are included in the fee.

The fee has to be paid after approval and before granting the EuroRec Seal.

Rate:

- 800€ Outside Europe
- 500€ Western Europe
- 350€ Eastern Europe (recent members of the European Union or candidate countries)

Retribution of 25% of the paid fees will be paid to the National Partner Organisation.

3. Testing of the application is done on request of the supplier and the quality assessment needs to be done by the EuroRec Institute.

The rate includes the costs encountered by The EuroRec Institute for performing the quality assessment and certifying that an application meets the criteria of a EuroRec Seal.

Rate for testing an application by EuroRec:

- 1.750€ Outside Europe plus travel and subsistence
- 850€ Western Europe plus travel and subsistence
- 500€ Eastern Europe (recent members of the European Union or candidate countries) plus travel and subsistence

4. Testing of the application is done on request of the supplier and the quality assessment needs to be done by a National Partner Organisation (ProRec centre or EuroRec Associate).

The rate includes the costs encountered by the National Partner Organisation for performing the quality assessment and certifying that an application meets the criteria of a EuroRec Seal.

The fee does not include services provided by another National Partner Organisation to assist the supplier in preparing the test session and the production of the required documentation.

The fee has to be paid before an appointment will be taken to undertake the quality assessment.

The fee is also due for unsuccessful testing.

Rate for testing an application by a National Partner Organisation:

- 600€ Western Europe plus travel and subsistence
- 350€ Eastern Europe (recent members of the European Union or candidate countries) plus travel and subsistence

There is an additional fee requesting in order to get the EuroRec seal granted. The National Partner Organisation is responsible for collecting that fee.

Rate for granting the Seal requested by a National Partner Organisation:

- 250€ Western Europe
- 150€ Eastern Europe (recent members of the European Union or candidate countries)

5. Services provided by National Partner Organisations

It is strongly advised, in order to increase chances of success, to hire the services of a National Partner Organisation. These are "consultancy" services. The rate should be agreed between that partner and the supplier

Related issues

1. Language of the product documentation

All the documentation needed to evaluate the application or the testing and certification done by a Third Party will be in English. Translation costs are due to be paid by the applicant before starting any evaluation.

Screens captures illustrating functionality of the system and display of its content may remain in the original languages. The screens need to be explained in English with references to field in the screen capture.

2. Same product in a different language for the same country and intended group of professional users

No additional fee will be required. Products need to be identical of course, language excepted.

3. Same original product from the same developer and commercialised in different countries (under the same or a different name).

Services (testing, assistance...) are provided at 60% of the applicable rate, except for issuing the Seal if issuing the Seal is the only service required. The fee for issuing the Seal applies for each Seal.

4. Second session

A second session should not be required with appropriate and convincing documentation. If ever required 60% of the applicable rate will be applied. Travel and subsistence costs are fully due.
